While this is an ever-changing answer, we've put together the most basic, foundational tools that everyone should have in their AI toolbox, based on the general task you're trying to accomplish:

For reading and writing text under 8,000 words	ChatGPT+, Mixtral 8x7B, Gemini
For reading and writing text over 8,000 words	ChatGPT+, or Mixtral 8x7B
For creating images	Microsoft Bing Image Creator, Google Gemini, ChatGPT+
For analyzing images	Google Gemini or ChatGPT+
For realtime information	Microsoft Bing or Google Gemini
For analyzing data	ChatGPT+ with Advanced Data Analysis
For sensitive information / restricted topics	Mixtral 8x7B or ChatGPT Teams
For writing code	ChatGPT+ or Beyond 4x7B
